In an effort to forge relationships with adult local actors and performers, The Old Globe will hold open auditions on Monday, June 3<sup>rd</sup> for *Dr. Seuss' How The Grinch Stole Christmas*, which performs October 15 – December 29, 2019. The Old Globe encourages adult actors and performers of all backgrounds, experiences, and Union Status (or not) to audition.

We are not looking for child performers at this time. The children's casting notice will be posted at a later date.

**SEEKING:** Male, Female, Trans, Gender Queer, and Non-binary singers of all physical abilities and ethnicities including, but not limited to: African American, African, Asian, Caribbean, Indigenous, LatinX, Middle Eastern, Native American and Pacific Islander.

**PREPARATION:** Please prepare your choice of: a 16 bar musical theater song; a short, upbeat song; an acapella song; or a musical piece that you feel showcases you as an artist and your range. A piano accompanist will be provided; please bring sheet music, if applicable. There will not be audio playback facilities, i.e. – iPod speaker, boombox, etc, available.

Please bring a headshot/resume or a recent picture of yourself and a listing of your related performance experience that includes your contact information.

In person sign up for an audition time starts at 4:30 pm and performers will be seen on a first come, first served basis.

**<u>DIRECTIONS:</u>** Auditions will be held in the House of Charm – Dance Room, located Alcazar Garden in Balboa Park.

The entrance to the House of Charm is across the street from The Old Globe, right off the Alcazar parking lot. It's best to park in the Alcazar parking lot or the Organ Pavilion parking lot (both free).
